Welcome/Call to Order

- T. Black called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m. ET

Roll Call

- I. Eliassen called the roll. N. Brown was absent.

Review and Adoption of the Agenda

- T. Black let the group know to vote via Zoom reactions.
- T. Black reviewed the agenda and called for a motion to adopt the agenda.
- **Motion:** C. Covert-ByBee moved that the committee adopt the agenda. M. Sobowale seconded the motion. All present voted in favor.

Review and Adoption of the Minutes

- T. Black reviewed the minutes and called for a motion to adopt the minutes.

- Motion: A. Price moved that the committee adopt the minutes. A. Cosby seconded the motion. C. Covert-ByBee and V. Beauchamp voted to abstain due to absence at the prior meeting and all others present voted in favor.

Discussion of Rule on Definitions and Plan for Next Steps

- T. Black called on N. Kalfas to overview the draft of the rule.
- N. Kalfas explained that this was based on the ASLP Compact Rule Committee's work, which they spent several meetings working on.
- Deactivate:
 - The group agreed the distinction between privilege removal, privilege loss, and privilege deactivation was an important one, and that deactivation was time-limited.
 - The group agreed that it would be best to get more information on the term from other compacts before proceeding
- Home State License:
 - The group expressed desire to show that the license issued by the primary state of residence and the home state license have the same meaning.
 - The group agreed on added language to differentiate between single-state license and home state license.

Questions and Public Comments

- The group considered switching to two-hour meetings but decided not to change the meeting length at present.
