Welcome/Call to Order

Roll Call

Review and Adoption of the Agenda

- Chair Daly reviewed the agenda and called for a motion to approve it.
- Motion:

Marketing & Communications Strategies

- Timeline Messaging to States
 - o "go live" date is scheduled for the last week of September 2025
 - o Four pilot states: AL, AR, LA, and MS will be live
 - Other states may be onboarded too; still TBD which ones, if any.
 - Travel company targeted outreach
 - Obtain company contacts (recruiters and marketing departments)
 - Share a step-by-step process sheet
- "First to Know" email list
 - Currently at about 1800 emails submitted.
 - Utilization is specific to letting people know as states operationalize
- Q: How is the OTCC engaging states that are not ready to onboard to CompactConnect?
 - o A: Two buckets of "not ready" states, OTCC meeting them where they are:
 - 1. Those who cannot conduct FBI CBCs may be eligible for "legal impossibility" pathway IF the OTCC passes a proposed amendment to the FBI CBC rule. Currently in review by the Executive Committee; will vote to move to public comment

2. Some states are in a delay because they are updating their licensing systems and want to ensure their transition is successful; prefer to use the new system once in place rather than use the old one and then have to switch; OTCC is supporting these states as appropriate.

 - Ex: Practitioners' option to drop license and obtain a privilege to practice
